

Hotspot 1: RWY Holding point A9 crossing North to South-Hot Spot area with history of RWY incursions.
Pilots are warned not to confuse TWY A with RWY 29R after leaving apron for DEP. Pilots are warned not to confuse TWY A with RWY $29 R$ after leaving apron for DEP. Hotspot 2: RWY holding point A7 crossing North to South -Hot spot area with history of RWY incursions. Pilots are warned not to confuse with RWY $29 R$ after leaving apron 5 for DEP.
Hotspot 3: TWY A between A6 and A5 - Hot Spot area with history of aircrattvenicle conflict. TWY A is adiacent to an airside road. Standard wing tip clearance not met. Pilots are to maintain good lookout at all adiacent to an airsise road. Stan
times. Maximum speed 10 KTS .
Hotspot 4: TWY E5-Taxiway E5 is used for helicopter operations. Any movement is prohibited during this operation on TWY E5.
Hotspot 5: Intersection of TWY A and El-Hot Spot area with history of potential aircraft confict. Pilots are to maintain good lookout at intersection.

Hotspot 6: TWY C between TWY C4E and C2-TWY C is used for helicopter operations and is parallel to
RWY 29L11R aircrattoperations. Pilots are to exercise caution and be preared to receive traftic information RWY ATC about departing/ariving helicopters. Helicopters are not equipped with Mode ACC transponder.
